## Level 3 Core Maths

Core Maths is a practical course, ideal for those students starting at Myerscough in September who possess a good GCSE pass. It provides the maths skills needed for higher education, employment and the personal finance of everyday life.

The intention is that students can study Core Maths alongside any of our Level 3 programmes. It often gives an edge for Higher Education, with universities valuing the 'soft' skills of judgement and reasoning that Core Maths develops. It is also worth up to 20 UCAS points (the same as an AS level).

Topics include personal finance, estimation and modelling, critical analysis, project management, data sampling and statistical skills. Find out more from our Maths and English Team, based in Richmonds Restaurant.

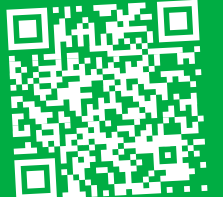

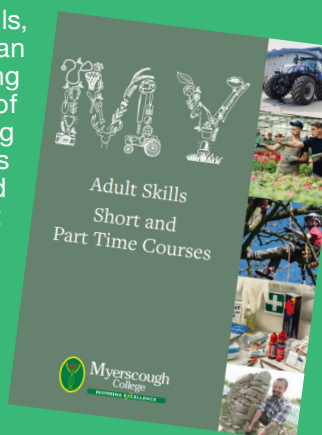

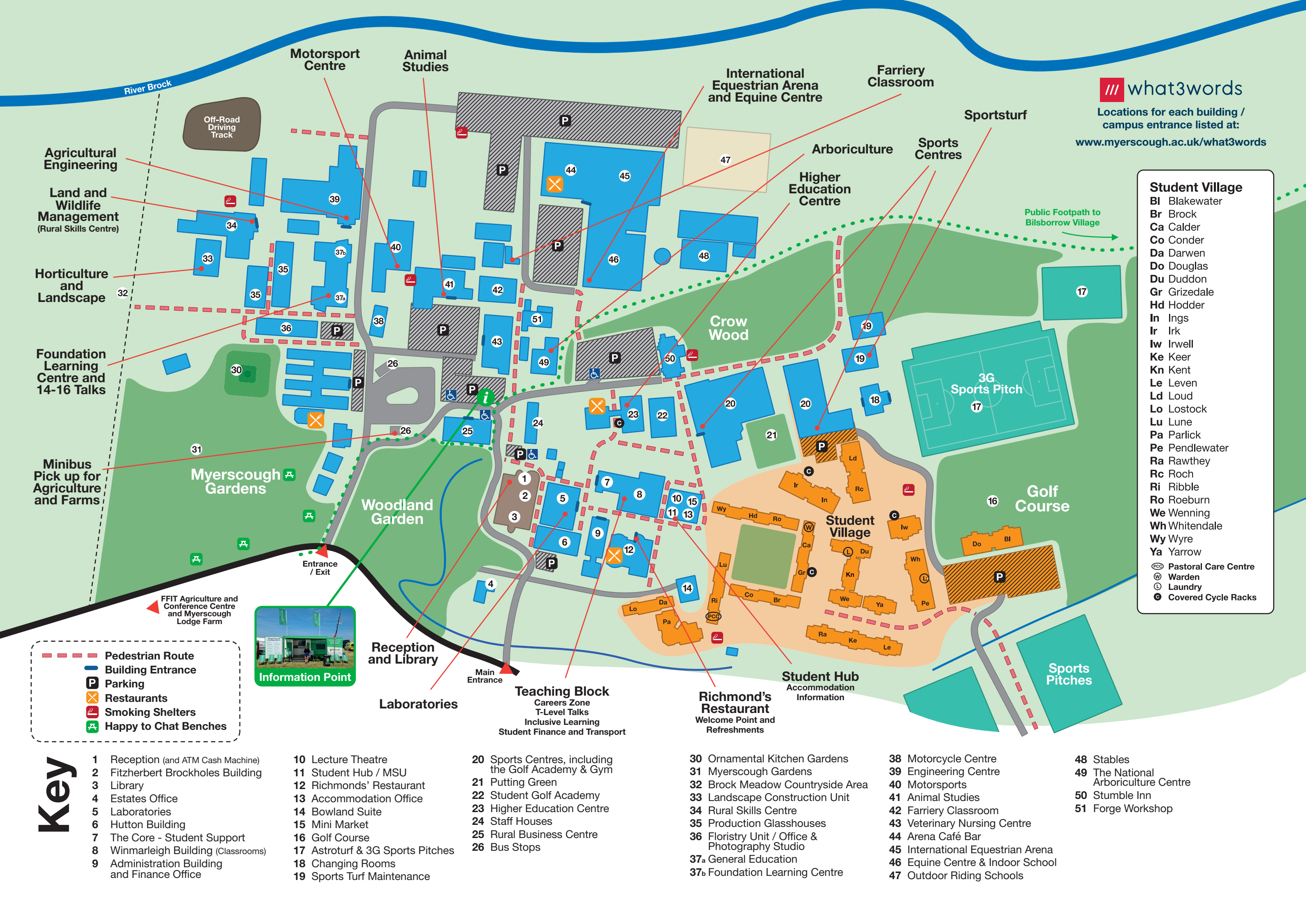
